Nonprofit Compliance Checklist

- Ensure timely IRS filings and maintain 501(c)(3) status.
- Adopt and review bylaws, governance policies, and conflict-of-interest statements.
- Maintain transparent financial records and annual reporting.
- Ensure board training and compliance with fiduciary duties.

Union & Association Leadership Primer

- Understand the legal framework for collective bargaining.
- Develop governance policies that comply with labor regulations.
- Maintain documentation of agreements and negotiations.
- Address disputes consistently with contractual and legal obligations.

Public Procurement & Contracting Guide

- Follow competitive bidding requirements for public contracts.
- Ensure compliance with state/local procurement laws.
- Avoid conflicts of interest in awarding contracts.
- Maintain proper recordkeeping for audits and oversight.

- Provide clear notice and hearing opportunities for students facing suspension/expulsion.
